IMAGES OF FINCHINGFIELD COMPETITION

The Guildhall Restoration Project Team are pleased to announce that it is running an Images of Finchingfield competition. Entry is open now and will close 19 July. All entries will be displayed at an exhibition Saturday 31 July and Sunday 1 August, 2–4 pm at the Finchingfield Village Hall, at which you will be able to vote for your favourites. We will then use the 12 best placed images to create a 2011 calendar, proceeds from the sale of which will benefit the restoration project. The conditions of entry are few and are as follows:

- Images can be photographs, paintings or other visual media.
- One calendar month will be reserved for the best placed entry from child aged 10 or under at the date the competition closes.
- A second calendar month will be reserved for the best placed entry from a young person aged 18 or under at the date the competition closes.
- The remain 10 calendar months will be filled by the 10 best placed entries from entrants of any age.
- The image must be your own work.
- There is no entry fee, up to three images per entrant.
- Each entry must be accompanied by a fully complete entry form.

You may take or create an image specifically for the competition or submit something you have previously taken or created. Subject matter is entirely open but should be of some element in the Parish, be that a picturesque village scene, village life in full swing or a detail from the wonderful countryside we have. We encourage you to take a broad approach the to brief, we'd rather not have 100+ photographs of the pond. Digital files should be of sufficient resolution to ensure a quality print at A4 size. Prints or artwork should be clean and in good condition. Please do not submit the original or your only copy, if necessary make a photocopy, or photograph artwork, for the initial submission.

Please complete the entry form on the next page and submit with your image, if submitting electronically, please scan the entry form and then post/hand in the original.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

You may only enter the competition once but you can submit up to three images.

You must not have created the image(s) in the course of your employment or under any commission.

You must not have assigned the copyright in the image(s) to anyone else or licensed anyone else to use the image(s).

The image(s) must not feature anyone who was not aware that you were photographing/including them or who has not agreed that you may enter the image(s) in the competition. For these purposes people will not be deemed to be 'featured' if they cannot be identified from the photograph(s) or if their inclusion is secondary to the main subject matter of the photograph(s).

Where the image(s) feature persons aged 16 years old or younger, the consent of that person's parent(s) or guardian(s) must be obtained prior to entering the image(s) in the competition.

Finchingfield Almshouse Trust will notify the winners and make publicly available a list of the winners on its website, with 14 days of the exhibition. Winners will be sent a copy of the 2011 calendar.

Winners will be selected by public vote held during the public exhibition. Two winning places, one each, will be reserved for entrants aged 10 and under, and 11–18 at the date the competition closes.

The Trust's decision will be final and no correspondence will be entered into.

COPYRIGHT

Ownership of the copyright in the image(s) shall remain with you but by entering your image(s) in the competition you accept that the Finchingfield Almshouse Trust will have the worldwide, irrevocable and perpetual right, without additional payment or permission, to use the image(s) and your name for any competition related promotional purposes in any media and to reproduce the images in any form for public sale.
